



ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini akan meneliti tentang kebijakan transfer senjata AS ke Indonesia pasca embargo 2005. Kebijakan transfer senjata tersebut disebabkan oleh tekanan sistematik di kawasan Asia Tenggara yang meliput perilaku negara-negara dan peningkatan ancaman oleh RRC di kawasan tersebut. Kebijakan transfer senjata tersebut juga disebabkan bagaimana pemangku kebijakan luar negeri mempersepsikan ancaman dan kondisi politik di Indonesia. Isu yang menjustifikasi isu transfer senjata ke Indonesia mengalami perubahan seiring dengan perubahan kondisi lingkungan strategis dan persepsi setiap pemangku kebijakan terhadap kondisi tersebut.

ABSTRACT

This thesis will examine the US arms transfer policy to Indonesia after the 2005 embargo. The arms transfer policy was caused by systematic pressure in the Southeast Asia region covering the behavior of countries and the increasing threat by the PRC in the region. The arms transfer policy is also caused by how foreign policy makers perceive threats and political conditions in Indonesia. The issue that justifies the issue of arms transfer to Indonesia has changed along with changes in the strategic environmental conditions and the perception of each policy holder on these conditions.
