

ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini membahas tentang perancangan bangunan Museum Situs Kedaton yang terletak di Kedaton III, Plered, Bantul, Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta. Skripsi ini dijelaskan mengenai usulan Museum Situs di kawasan Kedaton III. Plered merupakan kawasan arkeologi yang berupa sisa-sisa kota pusat pemerintahan kerajaan Mataram – Islam, tepatnya pada masa pemerintahan Sunan Amangkurat I (1645 – 1677 M). Lokasi situs Plered berada di Desa Plered, Kecamatan Plered Kabupaten Bantul, Daerah Istimewa Yogyakarta. Kawasan Warisan Budaya Kedaton III, Plered memiliki tinggalan budaya yang cukup dan dapat dikembangkan menjadi Museum Situs. Skripsi ini Merumuskan rancangan Museum Situs yang ditujukan untuk Pendidikan, Pelestarian dan Penelitian. Perancangan Museum ini merupakan gagasan / desain Museum sebatas gambaran rencana bagian tata pameran hasil penggalian. Tinggalan yang di analisis merupakan susunan bata yang diduga struktur benteng yang berada di wilayah Kedaton III.

ABSTRACT

This undergraduate discusses the design of the Kedaton Site Museum building which is located in Kedaton III, Plered, Bantul, Special Region of Yogyakarta. In this thesis, it is explained about the plan for the construction of the Site Museum to be built in the Kedaton III area. Plered is an archaeological area in the form of the remains of the central government city of the Mataram - Islamic kingdom, precisely during the reign of Sunan Amangkurat I (1645 - 1677 AD). The location of the Plered site is in Plered Village, Plered District, Bantul Regency, Special Region of Yogyakarta. The Kedaton III Cultural Heritage Area, Plered has sufficient cultural heritage and can be developed into a Site Museum. In this thesis, the design of the Museum Site is formulated for Education, Conservation and Research. In designing this museum, it is only limited to the Kedaton III area. The things discussed in this study are only limited to the design of the museum which is only a description of the plan for the exhibition arrangement of the results of the excavation. The remains that are analyzed are a brick arrangement which is thought to be a fort structure located in the Kedaton III area.
