

**PUBLIC SERVICE BARGAINS : INTERACTION, BEHAVIOR AND POWER
CASE STUDY OF DETERMINING BUDGET POLICY IN MAGELANG CITY**

ABSTRACT

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This study examines the Public Service Bargains (PSB) in the Determination of Budget Policy that occurs in Magelang City by focusing on first, the analysis of legislative and executive relationships within the framework of psb in determining budget policy. Second, the analysis of aspects of interaction, behavior and power that make up the Third PSB, the analysis of PSB that occurs in local government, The focus of this research is aspects of interaction, behavior and power between the executive and the legislature in the determination of budget policy.

Research with this qualitative approach using a multi-case study method. Key data and information are dug out directly from the legislative and executive actors involved in it. Data validity testing is carried out with a triangulation model that checks data from various sources (source triangulation) and uses various techniques (triangulation techniques).

This study found several important things, namely: First, that PSB in policy formulation in previous research PSB is formed from 3 (three) constituent components. So far, research and studies related to the PSB concept have been carried out in various European countries, namely the Netherlands, England, Canada, Belgium and Germany where differences in performance management systems, the history of a country's administration, including the traditional relationship between and administration determine the type of PSB as well as research on PSB's role in the placement of senior officials in Europe. The dynamics of PSB can also be explained by changes in positions within the ministry and the interests of political actors. A non-European country examines the utility of a public service system framework in a non-European setting namely Hong Kong, to better understand where PSB theory works well outside of Europe. From the results of the analysis of this research, PSB is also formed by aspects of interaction, behavior and power between politics and bureaucrats, especially in looking at budget policies.

The second refers to the first finding, that PSB is also formed by aspects of interaction, behavior and power, so PSB that occurs in policy determination, especially budget policy determination, then PSB that occurs has developed types, types and patterns that are not only seen from the reward, competency and the loyalty that shaped it. Analysis of aspects of interaction, behavior and power The third, PSBs emphasize the bargaining relationship in reaching an agreement as a way to determine a policy, in local government, it has different forms.
