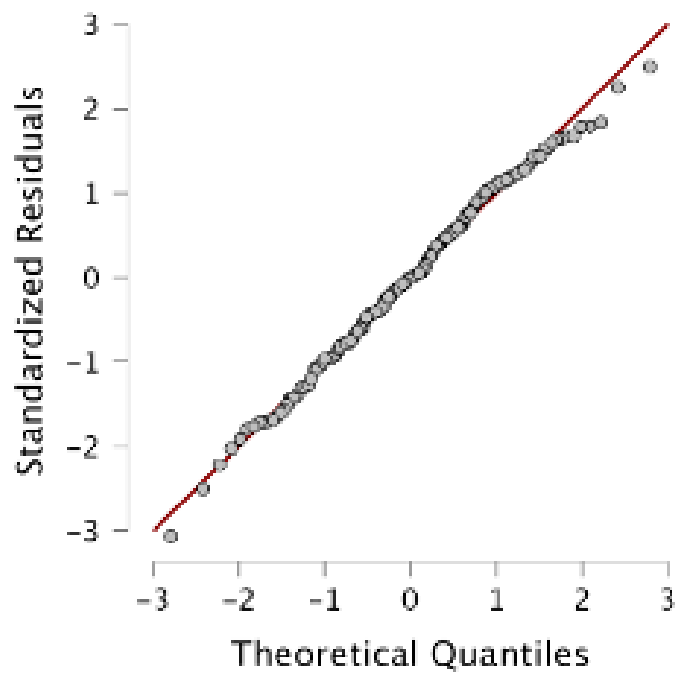

### Homoscedasticity Assumption Result

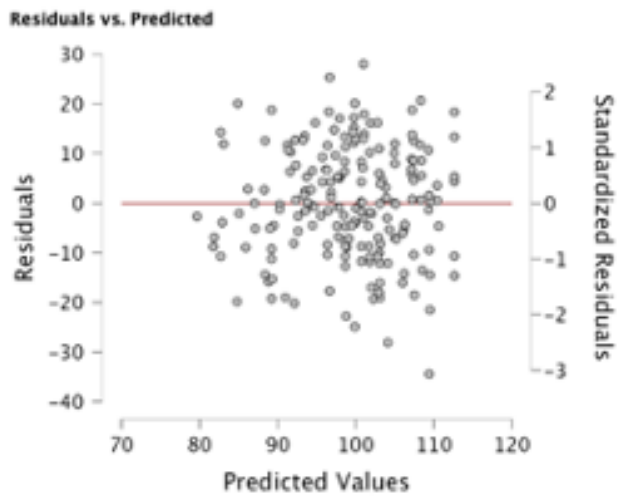

### Homoscedasticity Assumption Result - Residual vs Dependent

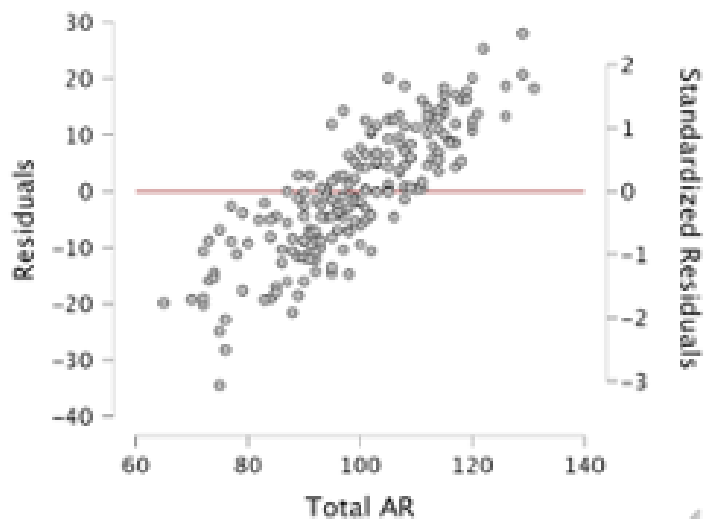
