Abstract

Local foods as a regional potency can promoted by cultivating understandable and interesting information, so that people will interest to delicacy this food. This research will make map that can give information about kind of local foods, place of the seller, and completed with rating of the seller.

Survey method was used in this the research and done by observation and giving questioner to the research objects. Research objects consisting of the local food seller or producer and people who know about both of location and variety of local foods. Local foods that showed in this map will select based on their taste and quantity of foods that can sell in a day. The local food that has been selected call popular food. The map made by computer applying Corel Draw 10.

This research produces two maps, Popular Foods Map of Bantul and Popular Foods Map of Gunungkidul. In Gunungkidul found 14 kind of popular foods that spreading at 27 locations. Popular foods that often found in Gunungkidul are "sate daging kambing" or barbecued goat meat, "soto ayam" or oriental-chicken soup, and oriental fried chicken. Almost of the popular food seller has located on main road between Yogyakarta-Wonosari-Wonogiri.

In Bantul found 21 kind of popular foods that spreading at 43 locations. Kind of popular foods that often found are "soto ayam" or oriental-chicken soup, "soto babat" or oriental-beef soup, "bakmi jawa" or Javanese cooked noodles, and many kind of cooked fish. The popular food seller can found at Wates Street, Bantul Street, Parangtritis Street, and Janti Street.
