

## ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini menganalisis dinamika konflik kebijakan perluasan PLTP Ulumbu ke Poco Leok menggunakan Policy Conflict Framework (PCF). Menggunakan pendekatan kualitatif berbasis studi kasus, data dikumpulkan melalui observasi lapangan, wawancara mendalam dengan pemangku kepentingan, dan analisis dokumen sekunder untuk memperoleh pemahaman yang komprehensif. Hasil penelitian mengungkap empat strategi resistensi berbasis praktik lokal yang dikembangkan Masyarakat adat Poco Leok 1) Pelaksanaan ritual sebelum dan sesudah aksi (*Teing Hang Empo*), 2) Konsolidasi rutin bulanan antar rumah adat yang menolak (*Lonto Leok*), 3) Sistem komunikasi krisis (*Benta Ata Beo*), dan 4) Sistem logistik mandiri untuk aksi jaga kampung (*Ba Hang*). Penelitian ini berkontribusi pada pengembangan konseptual PCF dengan mengungkap strategi resistensi berbasis praktik lokal masyarakat adat Poco Leok yang melampaui dikotomi *inside-outside strategy* yang diklasifikasikan dalam PCF.

## ABSTRACT

This research analyzes the dynamics of the policy conflict concerning the expansion of the Ulumbu Geothermal Power Plant (PLTP) into Poco Leok, utilizing the Policy Conflict Framework (PCF). Employing a qualitative case study approach, data was gathered through field observations, in-depth interviews with stakeholders, and analysis of secondary documents to achieve a comprehensive understanding. The research findings reveal four local practice-based resistance strategies developed by the Poco Leok indigenous community: ritual performances before and after actions (*Teing Hang Empo*), routine monthly consolidations among the resisting traditional houses (*Lonto Leok*), a crisis communication system (*Benta Ata Beo*), and a self-sufficient logistics system for "village guarding actions" (*Ba Hang*). This study contributes to the conceptual development of the PCF by uncovering resistance strategies rooted in indigenous local wisdom that transcend the conventional inside-outside strategy dichotomy, thereby broadening the scope of policy conflict analysis.
