### **ANALISIS STRATEGIS DINAMIKA KEPENTINGAN PADA SELEKSI CALON HAKIM AGUNG KOMISI YUDISIAL REPUBLIK INDONESIA**

Penelitian ini bertujuan menganalisis dinamika kepentingan para pemangku kepentingan dalam proses seleksi calon hakim agung oleh Komisi Yudisial Republik Indonesia. Latar belakang penelitian didasari kebutuhan memastikan proses seleksi berjalan sesuai prinsip transparansi, partisipasi, objektivitas, dan akuntabilitas di tengah tarik-menarik kepentingan. Metode yang digunakan adalah kualitatif dengan pendekatan studi kasus, melalui analisis dokumen resmi, publikasi lembaga, serta wawancara mendalam dengan narasumber dari KY dan pihak terkait. Analisis dilakukan menggunakan kerangka teori pemangku kepentingan serta konsep rekrutmen dan seleksi untuk memetakan posisi, kepentingan, dan pengaruh para aktor terhadap proses seleksi. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa dinamika kepentingan dipengaruhi interaksi antara KY, DPR, MA, Presiden, dan masyarakat sipil. KY berada pada posisi strategis sekaligus rentan karena harus menjaga kualitas seleksi di tengah tekanan politik. Penelitian ini menegaskan pentingnya koordinasi antar lembaga dan pengawasan publik untuk menjaga integritas seleksi, sekaligus memperkaya literatur teori pemangku kepentingan dalam konteks seleksi pejabat publik.

## ABSTRACT

### STRATEGIC ANALYSIS OF STAKEHOLDER DYNAMICS IN THE SELECTION OF SUPREME COURT JUSTICE CANDIDATES BY THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

This study aims to analyze the dynamics of stakeholder interests in the selection process of Supreme Court justice candidates by the Judicial Commission of the Republic of Indonesia. The background of this research lies in the need to ensure that the process adheres to the principles of transparency, participation, objectivity, and accountability amid competing interests. The research applies a qualitative case study approach, using data collected from official documents, institutional publications, and in-depth interviews with informants from the Judicial Commission and related actors. The analysis is guided by stakeholder theory and recruitment and selection concepts to map the positions, interests, and influence of different parties in the process. The findings reveal that the dynamics are shaped by the interactions among the Judicial Commission, the House of Representatives, the Supreme Court, the President, and civil society. The study highlights the importance of inter-institutional coordination and public oversight to maintain selection integrity, while also contributing to stakeholder theory literature in public official selection.
