

Peran Identitas Moral terhadap *Civic Purpose* pada Masa *Emerging Adulthood*: *Moral Self-efficacy* sebagai Mediator

**Abstrak**

*Civic purpose* merupakan intensi jangka panjang yang dimiliki warga negara untuk berkontribusi bagi kepentingan bersama dan menjadi salah satu indikator capaian positif pada masa *emerging adulthood*. *Civic purpose* sebagai manifestasi dari *idealized personhood*, diprediksi berkembang dari peran aset perkembangan internal yang dimiliki individu, diantaranya identitas moral. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menguji peran identitas moral terhadap *civic purpose* pada masa *emerging adulthood* yang dimediasi oleh *moral self-efficacy*. Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan pengumpulan data menggunakan survey secara online. Sebanyak 361 warga negara Indonesia berusia 18-29 tahun (Laki-laki = 95, Perempuan = 266) mengisi kuesioner penelitian yang terdiri dari demografi, skala *civic purpose*, skala identitas moral, dan skala *moral self-efficacy*. Hasil analisis mediasi sederhana menunjukkan bahwa identitas moral berperan positif terhadap *civic purpose* melalui mediasi *moral self-efficacy*. Implikasi penelitian ini menegaskan pentingnya mendorong internalisasi nilai-nilai moral ke dalam identitas individu dan keyakinan moral agar warga negara mampu mengembangkan *civic purpose* pada masa *emerging adulthood*.

**Abstract**

Civic purpose refers to a sustained intention of citizens to contribute to the common good and represents an indicator of civic development during emerging adulthood. Conceptualized as a manifestation of idealized personhood within the positive youth development framework, civic purpose is expected to develop from internal developmental assets that individuals possess, including moral identity. This study examined the role of moral identity on civic purpose among emerging adulthood, with moral self-efficacy as a mediator. A quantitative study was employed through an online survey. A total of 361 Indonesian citizens aged 18-29 years (Male = 95, Female = 266) completed a questionnaire consisting of demographics, civic purpose scale, moral identity scale and moral self-efficacy scale. Mediation analysis was conducted and showed that moral identity plays a positive role on civic purpose through moral self-efficacy. The findings highlight the importance of fostering the internalization of moral values into personal identity and moral self-efficacy to enable citizens to develop civic purpose during emerging adulthood.
