

ABSTRACT

The goal of this research is to find out the operation of UN peace-keeping force and the effect to their family condition, and also the implication of UN peace-keeping force existence to the economic resiliense of the soldier family.

The method in use in this research is qualitative descriptive method. This research is carried out in Army Military Police Battalion Force, located in Sima Galih Village, Jonggol sub-district, Bogor Regency, West Java Province. The population of this research consists of 22 people. The sample consists of 8 people taken through purposive random sampling which then separated into two different groups. The first group consists of the soldier who assigned into UN peace-keeping force in Lebanon and the second group consists of the wives who left behind by their soldier husband who assigned in UN peace-keeping force.

The result shows that (1) the duty of UN peace-keeping force in Lebanon has a high value to the soldiers. Even though the soldiers have to separate from their families for sometimes, they have high motivation to carry out the duties as UN peace-keeping force. The family support has important role for the soldiers to carry out their duties as UN peace-keeping force without family's problems. The operation force in Lebanon will give the soldiers new experiences and something to proud of. The existence of UN peace-keeping force operation in Lebanon will affect the soldiers in some matters such as family health, family education, family wealth, anxiety, and the existence of the husband in the family (togetherness), (2) the implication of UN peace-keeping force operation to the economic resiliense of the soldier family is very high. The rising salary could enhance the family economic to buy house, to build house, to buy vehicle, saving, and capital to develop productive activities such as printing business or buy some field to plant *sengon* tree. Therefore the soldier family economic resiliense is rising as the rise of the soldier's salary as they on duty as UN peace-keeping force. The conclusion is the existence of UN peace-keeping force affects the family condition in some matters and the implication on the soldier on duty as UN peace-keeping force family resiliense is high.
