

ABSTRACT

Indonesia has a long journey in applying decentralization. The breakthrough of decentralization in Indonesia was marked by the establishment of Law Number 22 Year 2009 about Regional Autonomy. It then followed by numerous establishment of other Laws. One essential part of decentralization implementation is local regulations making. To set a clear guidance for local governments, Law Number 10 Year 2004 about Establishment of Legislation was established by Central Government. To adjust to the latest regulation, development, and dynamism of society, this Law has been replaced by a new one by Law Number 12 Year 2011. It then followed up by lower regulations. Stages in establishing local regulations have been stipulated in Ministerial of Domestic Affairs Decree Number 80 Year 2015. But still, there are some local regulations stated to be dropped by Central Government due to some reasons. One of typical reasons is inappropriate content of the local regulation. This may shows lack understanding in applying the importance of each stage of policy making in drafting local regulations. It is resulted from various background of the actors, both discipline and work field. This study tries to investigate the implementation of local regulation making, particularly in Gunungkidul Regency. The objective of this study is to investigate the implementation of local regulation making in Gunungkidul Regency. It also aimed to analyze Gunungkidul Regency's strategy on improving the quality of local regulations. It will contribute a new perspective in setting the development of local regulations, especially in executive area since this field is very determining in the decision making.
