

ABSTRAK

Kejadian Dermatomikosis pada Kucing di Klinik Hewan Kuningan Yogyakarta bulan Mei-September 2019

Kucing merupakan hewan yang banyak dipelihara manusia. Hampir semua ras kucing dapat terinfeksi penyakit, salah satunya adalah penyakit kulit. Kasus penyakit kulit yang banyak ditemui adalah dermatomikosis. Penelitian ini bertujuan melihat gambaran kejadian dermatomikosis pada kucing selama musim kemarau yaitu bulan Mei-September 2019 di Klinik Hewan, Departemen Ilmu Penyakit Dalam, FKH-UGM. Penelitian ini menggunakan data sekunder berupa rekam medik pasien kucing yang didiagnosis dermatomikosis, bulan Mei hingga September 2019. Data kemudian dicatat dan dibandingkan berdasarkan bulan kejadian dan umur kucing. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa selama periode Mei-September 2019 didapatkan 60 pasien kucing dermatomycosis, terdiri dari 9 pasien pada bulan Mei, 4 pasien pada bulan Juni, 21 pasien pada bulan Juli, 8 pasien pada bulan Agustus, dan 18 pasien pada bulan September. Dermatomikosis diderita oleh kucing umur <7 bulan sebanyak 29 ekor, 7 -12 bulan sebanyak 12 ekor dan >12 bulan sebanyak 19 ekor. Berdasarkan penelitian ini disimpulkan bahwa dermatomikosis dapat menginfeksi kucing selama periode musim kemarau 2019 dan dermatomikosis terbanyak diderita kucing umur <7 bulan.

ABSTRACT

Cases of Dermatomycoses in Cats in Veterinary Clinic Kuningan Yogyakarta in Mei-September 2019

Cats are the most common as pet animal. Almost all breeds of cats can be suffered diseases, one of them is a skin disease. The most common case of skin disease is dermatomycosis. This study aims to provide an outline of the incidence of dermatomycosis in cats during the dry season, namely May-September 2019 at the Animal Clinic, Department of Internal Medicine, FKH-UGM. This study uses secondary data in the form of medical records of cat patients diagnosed with dermatomycosis, in the dry season from May 2019 to September 2019. Data is then recorded and compared based on the month of occurrence and age of the cat. The results showed that during May-September 2019 there were dermatomycotic cat patients consisting of 9 patients in May, 4 patients in June, 21 patients in July, 8 patients in August, and 18 patients in September. Dermatomycosis is suffered by cats <7 months old with 29 heads, 7-12 months with 12 heads and > 12 months with 19 heads. Based on this study it was concluded that dermatomycosis can infect cats during the dry season 2019 and most dermatomycosis affects cats <7 months old.
