

## PERAN *BIG FIVE TRAITS* PADA *TOLERANCE OF AMBIGUITY* DALAM MENGHADAPI PANDEMI COVID-19

**Abstrak:** Akhir 2019 dunia digemparkan dengan kemunculan virus Corona yang berawal di Wuhan, China. Pada akhirnya *World Health Organization* (WHO) menetapkan virus Corona sebagai pandemi yang dikenal dengan nama COVID-19. Situasi pandemi ditandai dengan ketidakpastian, kebingungan, dan keterdesakan, serta penyebarannya yang meluas di berbagai negara. *Big Five Traits* diketahui memiliki sumbangsih terhadap perbedaan individu ketika menghadapi situasi ketidakjelasan. Tujuan penelitian untuk mengetahui peranan dan hubungan dari *Big Five Traits* terhadap *tolerance of ambiguity* pada mahasiswa yang mengikuti pembelajaran *online* ketika menghadapi masa pandemi COVID-19 di Indonesia. Survei dilakukan secara *online*, data yang terkumpul dianalisis melalui uji regresi linier sederhana untuk mengetahui peran dari variabel independen (*Big Five Traits*) terhadap variabel dependen (*tolerance of ambiguity*). Hasil penelitian ini menegaskan bahwa *Big Five Traits* memiliki peran signifikan terhadap *tolerance of ambiguity* pada mahasiswa ketika menghadapi situasi pandemi.

**Abstract:** By the end of 2019, the world was shocked by the emergence of the Corona virus which began in Wuhan, China. World Health Organization (WHO) determined the Corona virus to be pandemic known as COVID-19. Pandemic situation characterized by uncertainty, confusion, urgency, and it spreads to various countries. Big Five Traits known to have contributed individual differences when faced with situations of uncertainty. The purpose of this study is to determine the role and relationship of the Big Five Traits on tolerance of ambiguity in students who take online course when facing the COVID-19 in Indonesia. The survey was conducted online, the collected data were analyzed through linear regression test to determine the role of the independent variable (Big Five Traits) on the dependent variable (tolerance of ambiguity). This study confirm that the Big Five Traits have significant role in the tolerance of ambiguity in students when facing pandemic situation.
