

ABSTRACT

This research discusses the uptake words that contain economic terms contained in the Java language weekly magazine Djaka Lodang volume one Legi Saturday, one June 2013 to volume 18 *Kliwon* Saturday, 28 September 2013. Magazine Djaka Lodang in providing information using Java language text, but also taking apart of the Java language. Languages taken derived from Indonesian and there are also of English. Intake of other languages because there is no proper word Java language to express the Indonesian language or English word corresponding to the meaning of a word taken. Thus there is the process of absorption into the Java language to interpret the words in Indonesian language or English, especially those containing economic terms.

Reveal economic terms in Indonesian language or English to be assessed morphologically and semantically to know the process and its significance. The study will show the word in Indonesian language or English absorbed into the Java language using either the prefix or suffix, suffix as well as the process of writing to the Java language so that the intended meaning appropriate destination information.
