

## INTISARI

Bantuan Langsung Sementara Masyarakat atau disingkat BLSM adalah salah satu program bantuan dari pemerintah berupa pemberian uang tunai untuk masyarakat miskin di Indonesia. Meskipun program BLSM di Indonesia telah banyak dinilai sukses oleh beberapa kalangan, tidak sedikit kritik dan penilaian kurang memuaskan dari beberapa kalangan baik dari segi teknis maupun dampaknya terhadap keluarga penerima. Berdasarkan beberapa kritik terhadap program BLSM terutama pada potensi penyimpangan penggunaan BLSM maka penelitian ini fokus meneliti Dampak Kebijakan Bantuan Langsung Sementara Masyarakat (BLSM) Terhadap Konsumsi Rumah Tangga dengan basis data *Indonesian Family Live Survey* (IFLS) gelombang 5 tahun 2014 dengan menggunakan metode *Propensity score matching* (PSM) dan regresi *Ordinary Least Square* (OLS). Hasil pada metode PSM maupun OLS menunjukkan dampak BLSM secara statistik berpengaruh positif terhadap pengeluaran konsumsi rumah tangga namun tidak signifikan.

## ABSTRACT

*Bantuan Langsung Sementara Masyarakat* abbreviated BLSM is one of the government's aid program for the provision of cash to the poor citizen in Indonesia. Although BLSM program in Indonesia has been widely stated a success by some societies, nonetheless the criticism and unsatisfactory ratings from some communities in terms of both technical as well as the impact on the recipient families. Based on some of the criticisms of the program BLSM mainly on the potential misuses of BLSM this research focused in examining Policy Impact of BLSM on Consumption of Households with database Indonesian Family Live Survey (IFLS) part 5 in 2014 by using Propensity Score Matching (PSM) and regression Ordinary Least Square (OLS). The results on the PSM or OLS method showed the impact BLSM statistically positive effect on household consumption expenditure but not significant.
