

## INTISARI

Tesis ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis dampak positif penerapan *Humanitarian Response Fund* terhadap peningkatan *capacity building* melalui jalinan kemitraan. Penelitian ini fokus pada mekanisme koordinasi penerapan *Humanitarian Response Fund* oleh UNOCHA dan YAKKUM Emergency Unit. Pengukuran peningkatan *capacity building* diukur melalui tiga dimensi yaitu tenaga kerja, modal dan teknologi, sarana dan prasarana. Data diperoleh dari wawancara dan sebagian besar dari tinjauan pustaka di beberapa jurnal, koran dan artikel-artikel online, serta referensi data dari internet. Penelitian tesis ini menghasilkan beberapa penemuan. Pertama, penerapan *Humanitarian Response Fund* berpengaruh positif terhadap peningkatan *capacity building* melalui jalinan kemitraan. Kedua, penerapan *Humanitarian Response Fund* efektif di organisasi lokal seperti YAKKUM Emergency Unit. Pengetahuan dan kesadaran pemerintah serta masyarakat dalam merespon tanggap bencana yang efektif merupakan hal yang pokok untuk menghadapi kesenjangan penanganan bencana di dunia.

## **ABSTRACT**

This thesis aims to analyze the positive impacts of the implementation of the Humanitarian Response Fund towards capacity building through partnership. This research focuses on the mechanism of coordinating the implementation of the Humanitarian Response Fund by UNOCHA and YAKKUM Emergency Unit. Measurement of capacity building is measured in three dimensions, namely labor, capital and technology, facilities and infrastructures data were obtained from interviews and most of the literature in several journals, newspaper and online articles, as well as reference data from the internet. This thesis research resulted in several discoveries. First, application of the Humanitarian Response Fund positive effects on capacity building through partnership. Second, the effective implementation of the Humanitarian Response Fund in local organizations such as YAKKUM Emergency Unit. Knowledge and awareness of governments and communities in responding to effective disaster response is essential to face a gap of disaster management in the world.
