

## **ABSTRAK**

Organisasi Internasional seperti Food And Agriculture Organization (FAO) sudah semestinya tidak diragukan lagi pengalamannya dalam menanggulangi bencana kelaparan di belahan dunia ini. Menyikapi krisis pangan yang terjadi di Somalia pada tahun 2011 – 2014, FAO berkerja sama dengan World Food Programme (WFP) serta Unicef menyusun strategi bersama untuk menyusun resiliensi di Somalia. Diharapkan strategi tersebut dapat menekan angka kelaparan yang tengah terjadi di Somalia pada saat itu. Pendekatan jangka pendek maupun jangka panjang telah dilakukan guna meyakinkan pemerintah Somalia sendiri untuk bangkit dari keterpurukan. Berbasiskan bukti serta data di lapangan, dapat diyakini pemerintah Somalia harus segera mengganti cara berpikir mereka yang dulunya mengandalkan kekerasan berbalik menjadi kerjasama antar lapisan masyarakat maupun komunitas-komunitas yang ada agar program jangka panjang FAO yaitu memperbaiki kualitas ekonomi Somalia dapat terlaksana dengan baik.
